MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN TEXAS.

May 11th, 1920.

Be it remembered that on this the 11th day of May A.D.1920, there was held a special meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof; Present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W.B.Treadwell, Commissioners, (Commissioner S.R.Parker being absent), L. Mitchell, City Manager, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:-

The question of providing and specifying the manner of payment by the property owners of property in front of which pavement is to be made of the proportionate one-third of the cost of such paving, was discussed by the members of the City Commission, after which it was desided that Mechanic's Liens should be executed by the property owners for the amount of the cost of same as assessed against such property, which is one-third of the entire cost of the paving, and that such liens should be made payable forty (40) days from the date of beginning actual work on the pavement. Commissioner B. L. Zeagler made a motion that the above proposition be adopted, which said motion was seconded by Commissioner L. L. Joods. The question was put before the commissioner by the Mayor, and each and all of said Commissioners voted for the adoption of said proposition, and the Mayor declared same carried and adopted.

An account of I. O. Warner in the sum of \$36.00 for team and wagon furnished in the "Clean up Campaign" was presented for payment, and by move and second duly made and carried, said account was allowed, and City Warrant ordered issued in payment of same.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried adjournment was taken.
