MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD DECEMBER 1st, 1931

Be it remembered that on this the 1st day of December A.D. 1951, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office on said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of former meetings were read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

A resolution entitled "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING MAYOR OF CITY OF LUFKING TO PROPERLY EXECUTED AFFIDAVIT AND BOND FOR WRIT OF GARNISH TENT IN CAUSE WHEREIN CITY OF LUFKIN IS PLAINTIFF AND C.H.HAR-RELL AND DOYLE F. HARRELL ARE DEFENDANTS, AND BY THE EXECUTION OF SUCH AFFIDAVIT AND BOND TO BIND THE CITY OF LUFKIN, was presented in due form and same having been read to the City Commission and it having been duly considered, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by W. A. Abney that same be passed and approved. Said motion having been put by the Mayor, the following is the vote recorded, to-wit: "AYES" Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W. A. Abney .- "NOES"-Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said Noneresolution passed and approved. (See another page of these minutes for the said resolution)-

The matter of raising the salary of T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, who is now acting as City Manager, the amount of \$25.00 per month was brought up by the City Commission, after which it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney that a raise of \$25.00 per month be granted to the said T. L. Dunn, making such salary now \$225.00 per month.

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It was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by C.A. Burke that Mayor Wm. A. Foster be appointed as a member of the Committee on unemploymnet with the Chamber of Commerce Commistee, The Motion carried.

It having come to the notice of the City Commission that Joe C. Denman had fenced up a portion of the alley at the rear of his residence, which said alley is the one just south of Mantooth Avenue and North of Frank Avnae and runs from Thompson Street to Kelley Street. The matter having been considered by the City Commission it was unanimously ordered that the said Joe C. Denman be instructed to reomove said fence.

City Fire Chief Harry Kerr appeared byfore the City Commission and requested that three steel cots be purchased for the Fire Department, and that one of them be furnished at this time. The matter was duly considered after which it was ordere that said request be granted, and Oity Manager ordered to buy the cots as aforesaid and Buy furnishings for one of them at this time.

Request having been made for installing two street lights as follows: one at the intersection of Homer Boulevard and Denman Avenue and one on North First Street at the what is known as the Thrash Candy Shop Corner, it was ordered and directed that said lights be installed.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
