MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON JUNE 18, 1946  
AT 4:00 P. M.

On this, the 18th. day of June, 1946, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof to-wit:

being present, with E. A. Gibbs, Commissioner Ward 1, being absent, thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. A proposition of Buster Feagin to secure right-of-way for a new road from Highway 59 to Highway 94 and just outside City Limits, was discussed. In the discussion it was pointed out that the City would not have any expense in securing the right of way but that its Engineering services were needed in making the location for the road. Without formal action it was agreed that the City Manager furnish the engineering at the City's convenience.

2. It was then moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin that the City, equally with the Lufkin Foundry & Machine Company, the expense of extending a storm sewer running through the Foundrys' property. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. It was then moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan that an ordinance be passed on first reading, setting the tax rate at \$1.75 per \$100.00, valuation for the year 1946. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
