MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPTEMBER,
23rd, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 23rd day of September, A.D. 1932, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

Wm. A. Foster,	Mayor,
W. O. Greene,	Coms. Ward No. 1,
C. A. Burke,	Coms. Ward No. 2,
M. M. Jones,	Coms. Ward No. 3,
W. A. Abney,	Coms. Ward No. 4,
R. C. Musslewhite,	City Attorney, and
T. L. Dunn,	City Secretary, and Acting City Manager.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Mr. Jack McDermott, Secretary of the Chamber of Commerce, was present again, and stated that he had received information about how to proceed in order to receive aid from the Federal Government through the R.F.C. Corporation and suggested that the City, County and Community Chest join in an application for a loan in the sum of \$25,000.00 to be used for Unemployment relief in Angelina County for the year 1932-33. After hearing the matter explained and having fully understood same, it was moved by W. O. Greene, and seconded by C. A. Burke that the application as outlined above be made. The motion carried unanimously and it was ordered that blanks be filled out making such application and that the Mayor and Secretary execute same.

It appearing that it was desired by parties owning property adjoining the City property, to-wit Lot No. 1, and 92 feet of Lot No. 2, Block No. 23 of the Original Townsite of the City of Lufkin, Texas, to submit to the Federal Government a bid for a Post Office site and that it would be necessary to include in such bid the property of the City above described, on motion made by M. M. Jones and seconded by W.A. Abney, it was unanimously carried that the City would take the sum of \$ 5,000.00 for same, net.

City Tax Collector, T. L. Dunn, presented for examination and approval the 1932 City Tax Rolls of the City of Lufkin, Texas. After carefully examining same, it was moved by C.A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney, that same be approved. Motion carried unanimously.

An ordinance entitled "ORDINANCE FIXING AND REGULATING MAXIMUM RATE AND COMPENSATION TO BE CHARGED BY ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION FURNISHING NATURAL GAS TO CONSUMERS IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR SUCH PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO CHARGE A HIGHER RATE OF COMPENSATION OR TO REFUSE TO FURNISH GAS UNLESS A HIGHER RATE OF COMPENSATION IS PAID OR PROMISED THAN IS PROVIDED FOR HEREIN, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR EACH VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE", was presented for passage and approval on first reading. The ordinance having been read to the City Commission, it was moved by M. M. Jones and seconded by C. A. Burke, that said ordinance be passed and approved on first reading. The Mayor put the question and requested all those favoring the passage of said ordinance to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No"- The following is the recorded vote "Ayes"- Wm. A. Foster, W.O. Greene, C. A. Burke, M. M. Jones and W. A. Abney. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading. The matter of procuring insurance for the Volunteer firemen of the City was discussed. On motion of W.A. Abney, seconded by C.A. Burke it was unanimously carried that insurance be taken on the volunteer firemen, taking the form of policy that provides for a premium of \$150.00 per annum.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
