

Lufkin Texas Dec. 3-1918

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this Dec 3rd 1918 with the following named officers present W. D. Newsom, mayor pro Tem presiding W. D. Price J. A. Behannon and Leas L. Bonner Aldermen and R. P. Walker, secretary when the following orders were made of record by the Council.

It is ordered by the Council that City warrants Nos 2765, 2806 and 2865 issued to G. C. Bass for the sum of \$25.00 each aggregating the sum of \$75.00 and payable out of the "Street & Alley Labor fund," be cancelled and a warrant for the sum of \$75.00 be issued to the said G. C. Bass payable out of the "Parse fund," of the City of Lufkin Texas in lieu of the above mentioned cancelled warrants

It is ordered that a warrant for the sum of \$133.21 payable out of the "General Fund of the City of Lufkin Texas" be issued in favor of the St Louis Southwestern Railroad Co. in full settlement of the City of Lufkin expenses in exterminating mosquitos in the City of Lufkin Texas during the year 1918.

Ordered that the City Secretary is warrants in payment to Mayor, Aldermen and City Secretary for their attendance at four Council meetings during the month of Nov. 1918.

Ordered that all minutes of the Council meetings in Nov. 1918 be and the same are hereby approved There being no further business the Council adjourned to meet again Tuesday night Dec. 10th 1918
