MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD JULY 6th, 1934.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of July, A.D. 1934, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to read and approved bills and to pass on second readings ordinances appointing the Board of Equalization and making the annual tax levy, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

Bills and accounts due by the City to various parties, firm and corporations were presented for payment, same having been read on motion duly made and carried were approved and City Secretary directed to issue warrants in payment of same.

An Ordinance entitled:-

"AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF
EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
FOR THE YEAR 1934"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading.

D. A. Campbell made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it pass second and final reading. The motion was seconded by W. O. Greene, The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "Ayes"- C.A. Burke, W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks, D.A. Campbell and W.A. Abney. "Noes"- None/- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

An Ordinance entitled:-

"AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TAXES TO BE LEVIED,
ASSESSED AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE
YEAR 1934 AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading.

W.A. Abney made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it pass second and final reading. The motion

was seconded by Louis Hicks. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on same: "YES"- C.A. Burke, W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks, D.A. Campbell and W.A. Abney. "Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed on second and final reading.

The question of acquiring by purchase or condemnation proceedings the necessary right-of-way to connect Highway No. 94 to the pavement on said Highway, or to pave that part of said Highway No. 94 lying inside the City Limits at the entire expense of the City, was thoroughly discussed. After discussing the question and it appearing that the cost of paving that part of the Highway lying inside the City limits would be less than the purchase or acquiring of the right-of-way necessary before the State would pave it, it was unanimously decided to have the present Construction Company, (Lone Star Construction Co) that are paving Highway No. 94, to pave said part lying inside the City limits.
