
and the following absent: W. D. Winston, Jr. and R. E. Melvin, constituting a quorum, at which time the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn who stated the purpose of the meeting was to approved the bills for the month of March and to hear the proposition of Messrs. Offht, Vaught, Brown and Curry from Tyler with reference to their coming to Lufkin and establishing a city bus line. The matter was discussed fully and it was stated that should the franchise be granted the company would put all new buses in service, and that the present plans were to begin with at least four (4) buses. The matter was passed without any action.


2. The bills were read and approved and ordered paid.

3. There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
