MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUF-KIN, TEXAS, HELD JUNE 2nd, 1931.

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of June, A.D. 1931, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office of said Gity, with the following officers of the city present and presiding, to-wit:-

Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, M. O. Greene, M. O. Greene, M. A. Burke, W. A. Abney, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent on account of Sickness. M. F. Daniel, R. C. Musslewhite, T. L. Dunn, ent, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

_ Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION TWENTY THREE OF AN ORDINANCE RECULATING THE INSTALLATION OF GAS PIPING WITHIN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, OF DATE JUNE 5th. A.D. 1928 AND AMENDMENT THERETO OF DATE AUGUST 6th, A.D. 1929 AND PROVIDING PENALTIES" was introduced for passage and approval as an emergency measure. After same was read to the City Commission it was moved by W.A. Abney and seconded by C A Burke, that said ordinance be passed on first reading and that the rules requiring ordinances to be read at two stated meetings be suspended and that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that same be finally passed. The motion was put by the Mayor and the following is the vote as made, "Ayes"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W.A. "Noes"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion car-Abneyried and that same take effect and be in force after publication after (For a record of said ordinance see another page June 15th, 1931. of these minutes). --000-

Mrs. D.H. Goldeberg has made application for the city to pay her the sum of \$5.25, same being for cost of having the water drawn out of her underground cistern, which said water she claims was made unfit to use by reason of a city employee oiling same against mosquitoes. The Matter having been duly considered by the City Commission and it appearing that the said Mrs. D.H. Goldberg had given the said City emploee permission to oil said cistern, and that the city manager had proposed

and it further appearing that the said Mrs. Goldberg had refused to accept the proposal to refil said eistern with city water free of cost, to refil same with City water free of cost to the said Mrs. Goldberg, it was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by C. A. Burke, that said claim be not paid. The motion was put by the Mayor and it carried unanimously.

- The matter of adopting the Annual City Budget for the period beginning April 1st, 1931 and ending March 31st, 1932 came up for final consideration. On motion made by W.A. Abney and seconded by C.A. Burke said budget was adopted as published with the following exceptions, to-wit:-

The amount of \$1,200.00 as set up in the original budget was reduced to \$1,100.00, this item being for Volunteer Firemen Compensation. - The item of \$300.00 as originally set up for the Lufkin Library was increased to \$600.00; it being moved by W.O. Greene and seconded by C.A. Burkke however, that the amount of \$25.00 per month only be paid until a proposed Library building be started in actual construction, at which time the amount of \$50.00 per month is to begin being paid, and at the same time the amount of \$25.00 per month not paid previous to the beginning of constructing such Library Building is to be paid in one lump sum. The vote on said motions being called for same carried unanimously.
