

The City Council of the City of Tufkin Texas met on this the 10th day of August 1917 with the following named officers present. K. Morgan mayor presiding W. D. Newsom, S. W. Hawthorne, W. D. Price and W. N. Coose aldermen, R. P. Walker secretary and W. L. Sullivan sanitary inspector

The report of W. L. Sullivan sanitary insptor read and approved and it was ordered that the sanitary inspector report all punters, who fail to have their toilets properly cleaned and pay for same, to the City health officer

It is ordered that the members of the Equalization Board, consisting of Dr. J. A. Taylor, J. E. Peavy and W. P. Berry be paid \$ 24.00 each out of the General funds of the city for six days service on said Board.

It is ordered that W. L. Sullivan be paid .50cts out of the Street & Alley Labor fund for hauling off one dog carcass

It is ordered that the City Tax Collector take legal steps to collect all delinquent due the city by making out a delinquent list of all such delinquent taxes and have it published so that the City Attorney may proceed to file suit against all delinquent tax payers of the city for the taxes due the City of Tufkin Texas

It is ordered by the Council that the mayor have maps of all Corporations doing business in Tufkin, including all Railroads, Telegraphs and Telephones and all other Corporations required under the law to file such maps or inventories

16 said maps or inventories to be filed in the office of the City Secretary of the City of Lufkin Texas and it is further ordered that the Mayor have all Corporations, doing business in Lufkin file such reports, as the law requires them to file, with the City Secretary.

Moved and seconded and so ordered that the Mayor instruct S. W. Henderson to proceed with his work in graveling the street or road between Lufkin and Kellys. The said Mayor to pay for said work in General fund scrip at par value - less whatever amount may be collected from the citizens living on said street or road.

Moved and seconded that the resignation of W. L. Jones as water Commissioner be tabled and it is so ordered.

There being no further business the Council adjourned.
