MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD AUGUST 4th, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 4th day of August, A.D. 1932, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of. the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wat:-

The purpose of the meeting was to further discuss the matter of entering into contract with Lenoir Hunt provinding for the erection of certain Sign Posts and Street Markers within the Corporate limits of the City of Lufkin, Texas, the erection of which is to cost the City of Lufkin nothing, and providing that the said Lenoir Hunt would be granted permission to sell advertising matter and attach to said sign Post or Street Marker.

The matter was thoroughly discussed by the City Commission, and it was again decided that action be deferred until some future date. C. A. Burke made a motion to that effect which was seconded by W. O. Greene. Same carried unanimously.

There being no further business too come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
