Motion prevailed that Alderman Singleton investigate the reasons why the City Organ would not publish reports turned over to them for publication.

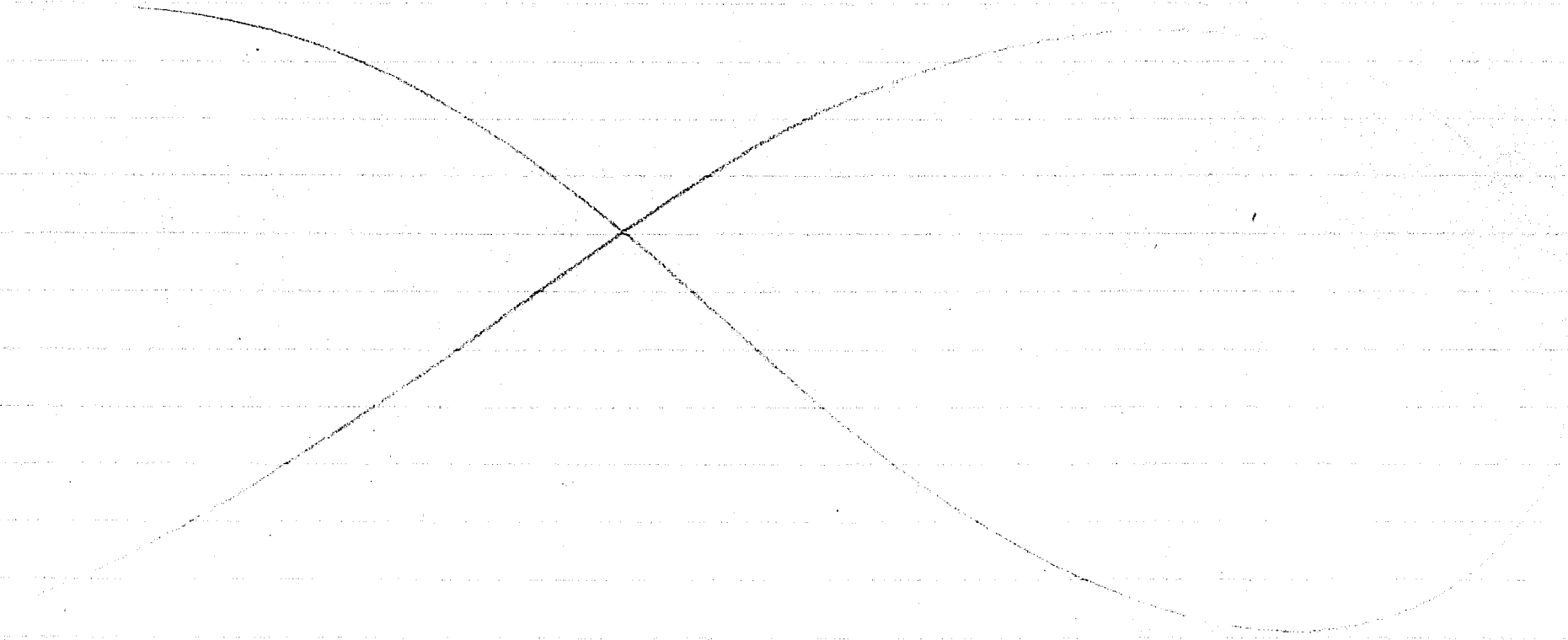
