

MINUTES OF CALL MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD Dec. 27th, 1921.

Be it remembered that on this the 27th day of December, A.D. 1921, there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof, Present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, E. E. Woods, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, (Commissioner S.R. Parker of Ward No. 1 being absent on account of sickness), T.L. Dunn, Acting City Manager and City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss in general with Mr. C. N. Humason, City Manager, who is to assume his duties as such Jan. 1st, 1922, the general conditions of the different departments of the City with regard to their different needs, and to, in a general way make Mr. Humason as familiar with the working of the City as possible so that he could enter upon his duties with some degree of knowledge regarding the City's welfare.

As above announced, a general discussion of the affairs of the City was gone into at length, for the purpose as outlined above.

Mr. C. N. Humason, City Manager elect, ask the city Commission to make an order allowing him the sum of \$25.00 per month for the purpose of general upkeep and running expenses of his Automobile when in use for the City. After due discussion of the question it was moved by Commissioner B. L. Zeagler and seconded by Commission E. E. Woods, to allow the amount above specified and for the purpose mentioned, which motion unanimously carried.
