

The City Council of the city of Lufkin Texas met in called session on this the 30th day of July 1918 with the following named officers present. K. Morgan mayor presiding S. W. Hawthorne W. D. Price, J. A. Behannon and Chas. L. Bonner alderman and R. P. Walker Secretary

The object of the meeting as explained by the mayor being to make arrangements for the Houston East + West Texas Railroad to procure a building or building for its general offices for its officials in the city of Lufkin Texas and after some discussion as to a location for said offices it was decided by the Council and so ordered that a part of "North Reservation as it appears on the map of the City of Lufkin Texas be declared no longer in the "Fire Limits of the City of Lufkin Texas and the said H. E + W. T. Railroad be permitted to erect a frame building on said part of said North Reservation for general offices.

There being no further business the council adjourned.
