D. 1927, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City; Presesent and presiding the following officers, to-wit:- J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E.W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale City Attorney and T. L. Bunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried, were approved as read.

There came up for discussion the question of installing a new fire alarm system for the City of Lufkin. A representative of the Gamewell Fire Alarm Company was present and presented his claims for the type that his company manufactures and installs, and after due and deliberate consideration of the matter, it was moved by Joe C. Denman, and seconded by M. C. Spivey that the City purchase a system from the Gamewell people at a price of \$8,200.00. The Mayor put the question and requested all who favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those who opposed to vote "No". The following members voted "Aye" J.W.Hawkins, Joe C. Denman, A. M. Walker, M.C.Spivey and E.W.Leach. The following members voted "no"— None. Whereupon the mayor declared the motion carried, and authorized the execution of a contract covering installation of said system.

On motion made by E. W. Leach and seconed by A.M. Walker, Shirely Simons was unanimously selected as Architect in connection with the erection of new fire station to be built at corner of Shepherd Ave. and third street.

There were quite a number of other things pertaining to the general welfare of the City discussed but no action taken regarding any of them.

All accounts and bills due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that all of such bills as had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, by move and seconed duly made and carried same were allowed.
