Further looking into the water situation confronting city Council and to the object of the meeting being to receive report of Mayor Thurason relative to L. L. & L. Co. financing the proposition of taking up the line of old 6" pipe from Stand Pipe to present pumping station, buying more larger pipe, and laying a complete larger line to new reservoir -

The report follows: L. L. & L. Co. propose to loan the city of Lufkin \$5000.00 at four percent (4%) interest - interest and principal payable in water furnished by the city ~~at~~ through a meter at 5¢ per thousand gallons water to be used as the L. L. & L. Co. may have use for same - This agreement to be closed by contract between the City Council and L. L. & L. Co. - Contract not to be transferable over

Motion prevailed that the council give a hearing to Mr Knapp representing A.M. Lecker, New Orleans, who offers to deliver certain pumping machinery for Lufkin for \$3500.00 guaranteeing the machinery to do a certain work at a certain cost, which cost seeming satisfactory to council, he was instructed to ascertain from his principals what terms they would offer the city on this machinery - and to report to council ~~report of~~ at ten A.M. March 28th 1911

Alderman Dr. R. W. Beason instructed to close up right of way contracts. Alderman McMullen & City Gray instructed to attend to legal part necessary in preparing papers for approval of Bonds - Meeting adjourned
