_____, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The commission voted unanimously to award the contract
for a new water well to Texas Water Wells, Inc. of Houston on
their base bid of \$50,900.00, in accordance with the recom-
mendations of Freise, Nichols and Turner.

2. The commission voted unanimously to purchase asbestos
cement pipe from ~~Viking~~ Supply Corp. on their bid at \$29,357.36
as being the lowest and best bid received and their letter of
June 6 stating that the pipe quoted was full diameter pipe.

3. City Manager ~~was~~ instructed to accept \$250.00 from
John Winston as his part of construction of proposed concrete
drainage way 286 feet west from the west end of culvert at
Persimmon and Bynum, provided John Winston furnishes the City
with a full release signed by him and by the other property owners
between his property and the creek.

4. City Manager ~~instructed~~ to contact the owner of property
at Kiln and Bynum relative to eliminating their open toilets.
