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1 Mr. Eugene Smith, Smith Electric Company, complaint about parking tickets for parking in an alley to load and un-load his truck at his place of business. City Manager suggested that he and the Chief of Police work out something to clear the situation. No vote.

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2 Several property owners, residing on Hopkins street protesting any zone change that might come before the Council in regard to their property.

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3 Dr. J. M. Martin (Col.) present in regard to Zone Change on his property in the Vicinity of Lake & Leach Street District, so as to enable him to build Retail Store Bldg., C. C. Sinclair made motion to grant him permission to build same. D. M. Thrash seconded the motion. Mayor put motion to Vote. All voted WAYE ", "Noes" None.

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4 Theron Williams, (Col.) presented application for Taxi-Cab license for two (2) Cabs to operate in City. C. C. Sinclair made motion to grant permit. D. M. Thrash seconded motion. Mayor put motion to vote. all voted "Aye" . "noes" None.

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7 A motion was made that the City Secretary and City Attorney be authorized to make tax adjustment on a piece of property on Lufkin Avenue 26'x70' owned by Almedia McChristie, Col., All voted WAYE". "Noes" None.
