

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD AUGUST 2nd, A. D. 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of August, A.D. 1932, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of all meeting held during the month of July, were read and on motion duly made and carried, were approved as read.

Mr. J. D. Martin, who has a lease on the City property known as Jones Lake, appeared and represented to the City Commission that he had done quite a lot of cleaning up, such as clearing away underbrush around the lake, repairing the fence enclosing the property and other minor things that he was not required to do under the terms of his contract with the city, and asked that he be allowed a credit of \$75.00 on his annual rental, which is now due the city, which amount so due is \$150.00, and that he would pay the balance of \$75.00 in cash. The City Commission heard his report, and after duly considering the same, it was moved by C. A. Burke, and seconded by W. A. Abney that his wishes be granted. The motion was put by the Mayor and carried unanimously. The City Secretary was directed to credit the said J.D. Martin on his rental account in the sum of \$75.00 for work performed and to collect in cash the sum of \$75.00 which two amounts would equal the sum of \$150.00, which would settle his account up to November 5th, 1932.

Mr. Lenoir Hunt of Houston, Texas, representing the PATHFINDER STREET MARKER COMPANY of said City appeared and requested or asked for a contract with the City granting to him permission and authority to erect certain Sign Posts and Street Names Markers throughout the City. The proposition being that such Sign Posts and Street

Name Markers free of cost to the City but that he, the said Lenoir Hunt would be given permission to sell advertising and attachd same to said Sign Post or Street Name marker.

After considering the matter, it was thought best to postpone action on the petition until a further investigation of the proposition could be made and the matter studied as to its advantages or dis-advantages; hence action was postponed until Thursday Night, August 4th, 1932.


Accounts and bills were presented for payment, and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly approved by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried were allowed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.


