Be it remembered that on the 7th day of September, A.D.1920, there was held a regular meeting of the city Commission of the city of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof; E. E. Woods, Mayor Protempore, present and presiding, S. R. Parker, Commission of Ward No. 1, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and W. B. Treadwell, Commission of Ward No. 4, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and Acting City Manager, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

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The City manager reported that City Marshall R. L. Mayne had resigned, and that he had appointed C. C. Mathews as City Marshall of the City of Lufkin, Texas. After considering the action taken by the City Manager, by move and second duly made and carried, such appointment is hereby in all things confirmed.

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other matters were discussed, but no action taken in regard to same, and it appearing that there was no further business to come before the commission at this meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
