

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON OCTOBER
12, 1949, WEDNESDAY, AT 2:30 P. M.

On this the 12th day of October, 1949, at 2:30 P. M., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in Special Meeting at the City Hall. The minutes of the proceedings pertaining to the issuance of Time Warrants for Water and Sewer Purposes are recorded on next page.

1. Commission introduced and passed an Ordinance changing the meeting dates of the City Commission to the First Thursday and Third Thursday of each month. (Proceedings set forth on next page.)

2. City Manager opened and read all bids filed with him for the construction of improvements to the sewage treatment plant pursuant to the published notice to bidders, which bids were as follows:

and after opening said bids, action thereon was deferred by the Commission to October 19, 1949, when a special meeting is to be held at 1:30 P. M.

3 City Manager presented a petition from property owners adjacent to the Lufkin Foundry Add. asking that the alley in the Hill Add. adjacent to their property on the South side of Jefferson Ave. be closed. Mr. Thrash made motion to close alley, provided all abutting property owners were in accord, Mayor Wright seconded. All voted "aye."

No other business. Motion carried to adjourn.
