

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL.  
LUFKIN - TEXAS.

August. 14th. 1915.

In obedience to the following call issued by Mayor T. C. Mantooth, there came on and was held a special called session of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas in the Council Chambers of said City on the 14th. day of August A. D. 1915.

" To the members of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas; City Attorney and City Secretary.

I hereby call a meeting of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas to be held at the City Hall on the evening of August 14th. A. D. 1915, the same being Saturday evening, at 8 P.M. for the purpose of settling with the Texas Bitulithic Company, raising funds for the water works department; purchasing machinery for the Water Workd Department; arranging for the rapair of the waste-way of the New City Pond and settling with the National Water Purifying Company and to attend to such other business as shall come before it.

The return of the City Marshall having been properly executed, the same is filed in the proper records.

The following business was had to wit:-

After considerable discussion, it was moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Davis, that the Council accept the proposition of Mr. J. L. Arlitt in full. On being put to a vote, all aldermen voted "Aye" and motion carried.

Also after considerable discussion, it was moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Davis that the Council adopt the Ordinance entitled " An Ordinance authorizing and directing THE CITY ENGINEER TO INTERPRET THE CONTRACT ENTERED INTO WITH THE TEXAS BITULITHIC COMPANY FOR PAVING WORK IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND TO COMPUTE QUANTITIES OF BASE AND BITULITHIC AND WEARING SURFACE BETWEEN CURB LINES." THE Ordinance being ordinance

It was moved by Alderman Price and Seconded by Alderman Davis that the Council allow the account of the Lufkin Light and Power Company. All Aldermen voting Aye.

It was moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Davis that the Council accept the Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DESIGNATING EXTENSION OF IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF STREETS AND MAKING CERTAIN REGULATIONS NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER ENFORCEMENT AND CONDUCT OF SAID IMPROVEMENT", the same being Ordinance #76 of the City of Lufkin, Texas. All Aldermen voting "Aye", ordinance adopted.

After much discussion with reference to the pumping machinery, it was moved by Alderman Fairchild that the Mayor appoint the following Officers and designated as a committee to meet Monday morning, the same being the 16th. day of August A. D. 1915 for the purpose of buying the necessary pumping machinery. The personnel being, Mayor Mantooth, Alderman Hawthorne and Engineer McCarthy. All Aldermen voting "Aye" and the Committee are hereby instructed accordingly.

There being no further business to come before the Council, it was moved by Alderman Price, the motion being seconded by Alderman Hawthorne, that the Council adjourn until the 20th. Inst. at which time they would meet to accept bids for the paving and other improvements. All Aldermen voting "Aye".
