The ordinance as passed is as follows:

AN ORDINACE

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, STREET IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 1948, IN THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$250,000.00)DOLLARS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAVING, IMPROVING AND REPAIRING STREETS WITHIN SAID CITY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF A TAX SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST AND CREATE A SINKING FUND FOR THE REDEMPTION THEREOF, PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF BOND, AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY.

WHERMAS, on the 28th day of May, 1947, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, adopted a resolution calling an election to be held in the City of Lufkin, Texas, on the 17th day of June, 1947, on the following proposition:

"Shall the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$500,000.00,

maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Commission, the maximum maturity date being not more than thirty (30) years from their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Four (4%) per cent per annum, payable annually or semi-annually, and to levy a tax sufficient to pay interest as it accrues and the principal as it matures on said issue of bonds, for the purpose of paving, improving and repairing streets within said City, as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas."

; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held in the City of Lufkin, Texas, on the 17th day of June, 1947, at which election a majority of the legally P-2 Feb. 14th, 1948

qualified electors, owing taxable property in said City and who duly rendered the same for taxation, voting at said election sustained the proposition to issue the bonds hereinafter described by the following vote:

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT BONDS" 681 Botes;

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT BONNS" 50 Votes, as is reflected in the election returns hertofore filed with the City Secretary; and

WHERFAS, the City has heretofore issued and sold **Two** Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) Dollars of the authorized Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars of Bonds, and it is deemed advisable and to the best interest of the City that the remaining Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000.00) Dollars of said authorized amount be issued at this time;
