Pursuant to notice duly given as appears herein, the City Commission met in called session for the purpose of considering the passage and approval of a franchise granting to the Dixie Gas & Fuel Company the right to distribute gas in the City of Lufkin, and for such other business as may properly come before the meeting.

The consideration of a gas franchise with the Dixie Gas & Fuel Company was had, and after duly considering same, no agreement could be reached as to the rates to be charged for gas, the matter was passed without granting a franchise.

An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance appointing the members of the Board of Equalization in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1927" was presented and on motion duly made and carried was passed and approved on second and final reading.
