The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to arrive at some definite conclusion and to give some definite instructions relative to steps to be taken in regard to collections on delinquent Street Paving Accounts. After due consideration and deliberation of the matter it was moved by Commissioner E. E. Woods, and seconded by Commissioner S. R. Parker, that the Gity Attorney and the City Manager be instructed to see all delinquents on Street Paving contracts and assessments and to collect not less than one-fourth of the amount due, with understanding that the balance unpaid will be paid in three equal payments within three, six and nine months respectively, and to file suit against those who do not pay said amounts and make arrangements for the balance as provided above. Said motion carried unanimously.
