MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON NOVEMBER 20, 1946 AT 3:30 P. M.

On this, the twentieth day of November, 1946, A. D., the City Commission met in a called meeting in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members, thereof, to-wit:

being present, with D. M. Thrash and E. A. Gibbs, Commissioners, being absent, thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

- LAfter a brief discussion, it was moved by L. C. Martin and seconded by B. F. Milligan that the Zone classification be changed from Zone B to Zone F, on lots 5,6,7,8 of Block 3 of the Clark Addition and all of block 2 of the Clark Addition. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.
- 2 It was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin that the application of C. D. Acker to change the Zone of block one of the Clark Additon be rejected. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.
- An application for a zone change by Mr. Everitt Haley was read for the first time. There had been previously filed, two petitions in protest to this zone change from residence citizens in the Eastwood Addition and from members of the Lutherian Church. Also present in protest of the zone change was Mrrs. Ward, Smith, Nesbitt, Connell and Brown, who stated that since this application was to lower the zone to a district low enough to permit the erecition of a packing plant, that they thought that it would be determental to their comfort to have the plant located so near their homes. Mr. Everitt Haley fort to have the plant located so near their homes. Mr. Everitt Haley was also present and stated that since the protest was a complete surprist to him, that he would appreicate a later hearing on the matter. After some discussion it was agreed to postpone hearing on this application until the regular meeting in December.
- Martin to change zones as requested by Mr. J. T. Hudgens. Motion carried by unanimous vote. It was moved by L. C. Martin and seconded by B. F. Milligan to pass the zone change as requested by H. L. Bean. Both ordinances are attached and become a part of these minutes.
- 5 It was moved by L. C. Martin and seconded by B. F. Milligan that a resolution be passed authorizing the sale of a portion of lots 1 and 2 and 3 of block 4 of the Haley Addition to the town of Lufkin to Sammy Jay. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea and the resolution is herewith attached.
- Brief discussions concerning an ordinance governing the parking meters was discussed, but no official action was taken. The need for additional jail space was also discussed without official action.

There being no further business presented, the meeting adjourning.
