being present, and the following absent: G. E. Brazil, City  
Attorney, constituting a quorum when the follow-  
ing business was transacted:

1. Mayor Woodrow W. Scott stated the purpose of the special meeting was in the interest of the T. L. Smith & Company of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, locating their plant in the City of Lufkin. Col. C. C. Chambers appeared before the Commission and stated that the T. L. Smith & Company of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, wanted to purchase an additional ten (10) acres of land out of the municipal airport tract, from the City of Lufkin, such additional ten (10) acres needed for the industrial site for said company. It was agreed to sell the additional ten (10) acres for the sum of \$6,000.00, and Col. Chambers was instructed that in the event the company thought \$6,000.00 was too high, then the City would reduce the price to \$5,000.00.

2. There being no further business to come before the meeting, it adjourned.
