MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD June 3,  
1941 AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the 3rd day of June, A. D. 1941, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in regular session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Minutes of the meetings held during the month of May were read and approved.
2. Reynolds & Sutton presented contracts for paving four blocks in the Newsome Addition on Jefferson and Avondale streets. The proceedings for passing and approving these contracts will be found following these minutes.
3. Jim Pinkerton presented an outline of the air port situation and explained the necessity for immediate action if the city is to secure a class 3 air port. It was suggested that the city provide \$450.00 for making a master plan by competent engineers. Upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by W. A. Green, the City agreed to pay \$450.00 for engineering fees.
4. Mr. Berry requested the Council to pave Lufkin Avenue from Fourth Street east one block, and the Council asked the Manager to look into the matter and report.
5. Gill H. DeWitt requested a refund of license fee tax paid on marble machine. He stated the reason for his request was that the State had ordered all marble machines removed. Upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by Cary C. Trevathan, it was decided to refund for the unused time paid for.
6. Mr. Spear of the Texas Power & Light Company addressed the Council and repeated his offer to pay the City \$2,980.00 as a gross receipts tax. After a full discussion of the matter, it was decided that the City would be willing to accept \$3000.00 for one year in lieu of the contract as presented. All commissioners present voted "YEA", except Cary C. Trevathan, who voted "NAY". It was decided to

accept the proposition of United Gas Company with reference to the gross receipts tax.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and seconded, adjourned.
