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MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS HELD JUNE 27, 1940 at 3 P.M.

The City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in a called meeting on June 27, 1940 at 3 p.m. at the regular meeting place with the following members present:

and the following absent: COMMISSIONER J. E. JAY, WARD NO. 4., constituting a quorum when the following proceedings were had:

1. Mr. Oscar Koch and Fred Dellone were present at the meeting, and the City Attorney outlined to the Commission all of the information which he had obtained in interviews with the Law Firm of Goggans and Ritchie and the First National Bank in Dallas, with reference to the paving project and the paving papers. Mr. Dellone submitted a proposition to go to work at \$1200 per month to contract property owners on the streets and act as managing contractor. No action was taken.

2. Upon motion of Commission G. E. Barington, and Seconded by Commissioner W. D. Winston, Jr., Mr. Koch was instructed to draw the necessary papers for receiving bids on the first unit of the paving project. All present voted "AYE".

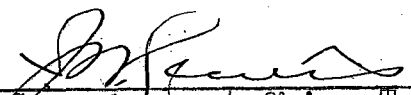
3. It was decided to notify the public and property owners to come to the City Hall to sign petitions for paving so that the Council would know what streets to include in the next project.

4. An application for putting in two 2000 gallons gasoline storage tanks in the alley in the rear of Robert Denum's Warehouse was referred to the Mayor, the City Manager and Fire Chief to see if this could be done without creating a fire hazard or violating the fire zone regulations.

5. There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
