MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD JULY 11th, 1933.

Be it remembered that on this the 11th day of July, A.D. 1933 there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the city present and presiding, to-wit:-

W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4 was absent.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to read the bills and allow same, and to pass on second reading an ordinance appointing the Board of Equalization for the City for the year 1933, and to transact any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

All bills and accounts owing by the city to various parties, firms and corporations were read to the City Commission and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly approved for payment by the City Manager should be paid, it was moved and seconded and carried that same be allowed.

An ordinance appointing the Board of Equalization for the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1933 was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. Same having been read to the City Commission it was moved by W.O. Greene, and seconded by C.A. Burke that said ordinance be passed and approved on second and final reading. The following is the vote on the motion: "AYES"- Wm.A. Foster, W.O. Greene, ^{C.A. Burke} D.A. Campbell. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.
