constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The minutes of all meetings held during the month of March
were read and approved. C

2. Commissioner Cary C. Trevathan introduced a resolution canvass-
ing the returns and declaring the results of an election held for
the purpose of electing a commissioner from ward number 2 and ward
number 4, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Melvin, and passed by the
following votes:

CARRIED. The resolution immediately follows these minutes.

Commissioner R. E. Melvin introduced an ordinance canvassing
returns and declaring the results of a special election held for
the purpose of electing a commissioner from ward number 3, and ordered
ordering a special election to be held for the purpose of submitting
the names of the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes
cast at an election held on April 7, 1942, and moved that the same be
placed on first reading, seconded by Commissioner J. E. Jay and
passed by the following votes:

CARRIED. Ordinance placed on first reading.

Upon motion of Commissioner J. E. Jay, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Melvin, said ordinance passed first reading by the following votes:

Commissioner Cary C. Trevathan moved that the ordinance be passed on first reading, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Melvin and carried by the following vote:


