MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS, HELD MAY 5TH, 1936

Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of May A.D. 1936, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit: Kenneth Hoskins, Mayor, W. O. Greene, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, Lewis Hicks, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. E. Jay, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, Curtis W. Fenley, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of meetings held during the month of April 1936, were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

The question of making proposal to U.S. Forest Service to lease to them the J.E. Wilson place for offices etc. of said Forest Service was discussed and on motion made by Lewis Hicks, Seconded by J.E. Jay, it was carried that a proposal be made, lease to run for a period of one year from July 1st, 1936 to July 1st, 1937, at a price of \$50.00 per month. The City Manager was authorized to execute in the name of the City such proposal.

The delinquent Tax Record covering period from 1919 to 1934, inclusive, was presented to the City Commission for examination and approval. After examining same and discussing the matter generally, it was moved by W.O. Greene and seconded by J.E. Jay that said Delinquent tax record be approved. The motion was put by the Mayor and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "Ayes"- Kenneth Hoskins, W.O. Greene, Lewis Hicks, J.E. Jay. "Noes"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said Delinquent Tax duly approved.
