

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 13, 1945,  
at 7:00 P. M.

On this the 13th. day of June, 1945, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: James A. Abney, Commissioner Ward 4  
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

1. An ordinance changing a portion of Zone B to Zone F was introduced for passage on second reading by D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan; <sup>DIV. Hwy 59 out of M. Simpson Survey</sup> ~~too~~ <sup>and</sup> passed on by all members present voting yea.

1 An ordinance changing a portion of Zone E to Zone F, was introduced for  
2 passage on second reading by B. F. Milligan and seconded by E. A. Gibbs  
3 and passed on by all members present voting yea.

3 An ordinance setting the tax rate for the City at \$1.75 for the year 1945, half of which is to be put in the General Fund and half in the Interest and sinking fund, was introduced by D. M. Thrash and seconded by E. A. Gibbs. Passed on first reading by all members present voting yea.

4 Upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by E. A. Gibbs and passed on by all members present the following citizens were appointed to serve as the Tax Equilization Board for the year 1945:

7 An application signed by C. F. Woods for the A. E. Percy Estate to change a portion of Zone B to Zone L, and an application signed by H. T. Bowers to change portion of Zone F to Zone G, were read for the first time, and Friday, June 22, 1945, at 10:00 A. M. set for public hearing.

4 An application of J. M. Mason to erect a gasoline service station on highway 59 was read. After brief discussion, it was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by E. A. Gibbs to grant the permit. The motion was carried by unanimous vote of yea.

No further business was brought up, so the meeting adjourned.
