L Minutes of the regular meeting held Tuesday, May 1, 1945, and a called meeting held Wednesday, May 9, 1945 at 3:00 P.M. were read and approved.

2. Cecil Massingill, who had resigned as Assistant City Health Officer, appeared before the Commission and stated that he had worked for a period of one year without a vacation, and requested that a fifteen-day vacation be granted him. A motion was made by B.F. Milligan and seconded by D.M.Thrash that this vacation be granted. The motion was carried with unanimity.

3. Motion was made by J.A. Abney and seconded by E.A. Gibbs to adopt the 1945-1946 Budget, as set forth by the City Manager and published in the Lufkin Daily News, Friday, May 18, 1945. The motion was carried with unanimity.

4. An application to change a portion of Zone B to Zone F, signed by Joe Watkins and an application to change a portion of Zone E to Zone F, signed by eight property owners near the site, was read for the first time. Both applications were recommended by the Zoning Board and publication of same was authorized. A meeting for public hearing on the above application was set for Wednesday, June 13, 1945, at 7:00 P.M.

5. A meeting was called for Friday, June 8, 1945, at 9:30 A.M. for the purpose of reviewing current City Bills for the Month of May 1945.

No further business was brought up, so the meeting adjourned at 9:00 P. M.
