D. A. Campbell, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent on account of sickness.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meetings was stated to be to consider the appli-
cation of Morey & Morey, Contractors, to have waived any penalty being as-
sessed against them for failure to complete Contract for construction of
Waterworks Improvements under P.W.A- Project Texas-1776-R. The letter
making the application to waive the penalty to be charged, if any, was
read to the City Commission. It was considered from every view point,
and it appearing that much time would be lost and final settlement of
the contract price delayed on account of holding up by the PWA of the
grant given by the government, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded
by J. E. Jay that no ordinance be passed waiving the penalty, if any,
on account of failure to complete the contract within the time limit
as fixed by the same. The motion carried unanimously.
