constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

1. Minutes of the regular meeting of June 5, 1945 and called meetings of June 8, 1945 June 13, 1945 and June 22, 1945, were read and approved.

2. Mr. Brown and Mr. Curry of Tyler, Texas, appeared before the Commission in the interest of a proposed change in the City Bus routes. After a brief discussion on the matter, action was deferred until a later meeting.

3. W. F. Jones of the Union Cab Co., was present and asked permission to place a trailer house on Lot 9, Block 8 of the Original Townsite of Lufkin, to be used as an office for the Cab Co. It was pointed out that this location was in the fire limits and was a matter for the City Manager and City Attorney to settle.

4. An ordinance changing a portion of District B to District L of the zoning map located at the corner of Abney Avenue and Sayers Street was passed on second reading.

5. Upon motion of D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan and passed by unanimous vote, Maurice Hicks was appointed as a member of the zoning board to fill a vacancy created by E. A. Gibbs becoming a City Commissioner.

No further business was presented so the meeting adjourned.
