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MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON MAY 14, 1946,
AT 3:00 P. M.

On this, the 14th. day of May, A. D., 1946, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof to-wit:

being present, with none absent, thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was called for the purpose of a public hearing on the following zone change applications: Warren Alfred, portion of C to F: Tyler Transit Co., portion of F to H and R. L. Perkins, a portion of B to F. There were no citizens present to object to the Zone changes and upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin, all changes were approved by unanimous vote.

2. The matter of getting the Water and Sewer account of the Angelina County Hospital on a current basis was brought up and discussed at length. After the discussion it was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan to cancel all indebtedness of the Angelina County Hospital as of April 20, 1946, and that the City Secretary be instructed to discontinue the service if the account was not paid on a current basis from April 20, 1946. The motion carried by all members voting yea.

3. Without official action, Mr. Lewis was authorized to give the Moore Chair Co. temporary location in the City Warehouse.

4. The 1946-1947 budget was examined and some adjustments recommended. Official action was withheld until after a public hearing.

5. A future planning board for the City, consisting of Arthur Temple, Jr, Barney Franklin and D. M. Thrash was appointed by Mayor Winston.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
