

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD JUNE 11, 1935.

Be it remembered that on this the 11th day of June, A.D. 1935, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings, were had, to-wit:-

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE OFFICE OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR¹ AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TO REGULATE AND DEFINE THE DUTIES OF SUCH OFFICE AND TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRIC WIRING AND APPARATUS, TO FIX PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISION AND REPEALING ALL LAWS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR PERMIT FEES, FOR THE INSPECTION THEREOF, AND LICENSING ELECTRICIANS", was presented for passage

and approval on second and final reading. It was moved by W.A. Abney that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading, and that it pass second and final reading. The motion was seconded by Louis Hicks. The Mayor pro tem put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "Ayes"- W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks and W.A. Abney. "Noes"-None. Whereupon the Mayor Pro Tem declared the motion carried and the said ordinance finally passed and approved on second reading. (See another page of these minutes for a record of said ordinance)

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR A.D. 1935, was presented for passage on second and final reading. Louis Hicks made a motion which was seconded by W.A. Abney that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading, and that it pass second and final reading. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the Motion: "Ayes"- W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks, and W.A. Abney. "Noes"-None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance finally passed and approved on second reading.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TAXES TO BE LEVIED, ASSESSED AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 1935 AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED", was presented for passage and approval on second and final reading.

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Louis Hicks made a motion which was seconded by W.A. Abney that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that it be passed and second and final reading. The Mayor Pro tem put the motion and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "Ayes"- W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks and W. A. Abney. "Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor Protem declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed on second and final reading. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the ordinance)

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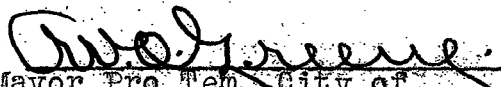
There came for consideration the adoption of the City Budget for the fiscal year beginning April, 1st, 1935 and ending March 31st, 1936, and it appearing that said budget as proposed for adoption had been heretofore prepared as provided by Charter and that it had been published as required by Charter and that this date, June 11th, 1935, is the date set for public hearing on same. It further appearing that no one appeared at the public hearing and no protests had been made or filed against the adoption of the budget as proposed, it was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by Louis Hicks that the budget as advertised and published be adopted in full. The Mayor Pro Tem put the motion and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "Ayes" W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks and W.A. Abney. "Noes"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the Budget as aforesaid adopted. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the Budget)-
