

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD JULY THE 5th. 1922.

Be it remembered on this the 5th. day of July A. D. 1922 there was begun and holden A regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin at the Municipal office thereof: present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley Mayor, S. R. Parker Commissioner #1 E. E. Woods Commissioner #2, B. L. Zeagler Ward #3 W. B. Treadwell Commissioner Ward #4 C. N. Humason City Manager, C. H. Rice Secretary W. O. Seale City Atty. and P. A. McCarty City Engineer, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of former meeting read and approved.

Mr. Kurth and Mr. Tullos representing the Angelina Hotel met with the City commission with reference to the fixing of rates to be charged for sewerage for the above hotel after A general discussion of all present moved by Zeagler seconded by Woods to set the rate of the Angelina Hotel at \$65.00 per quarter and the Bonner Hotel at \$50.00 per quarter, same having been submitted by vote to the City Commission, same carried unanimously.

N. D. Shands Representing the Lufkin Light & Power Plant met with The City Commission with reference to lighting up of the town, after considerable discussion moved by Zeagler seconded by Parker to instruct City Manager Humason to enter into contract with The Lufkin Light & Power with the approval of the City Attorney to erect whatever material is necessary for the lighting of same not to exceed the rate of \$2500 per year, same having been submitted by vote to the City Commission, same carried unanimously.

The discussion of the Water situation was talked of at great length after which it was decided to postpone this subject untill some future date.

Report of the Profiles of the new Sewer extension being presented and discussed same was postponed for the present.

-----oOo-----


