MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE GITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LURKIN, TEXAS, HELD JULY 7th. 1985.

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of July, A.D. 1925, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and C. H. Rice, Assistant City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and by move and second duly made and carried were approved as read.

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Mayor J.W. Hawkins read a letter receivedby him from Mr. Micksch, Supt. H.E.& W.T.Ry. proposing to pay the City of Lufkin all money paid out by it on the Fireman's Park as affects 11 feet of land claimed by the Railroad Company, except money paid out by the City in installing a storm sewer through said strip of land. After discussing the matter, Joe C. Denman made a motion which was seconded by A. M. Walker, that the proposition as aforesaid be refused, that is to say that the money proposed to be paid by the Railraad Company not be accepted. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. H. L. Thackwell, Engineer in charge, presented the specifications for construction of sewer disposal plant and sewer lines for the improvement of the sewer system of the city. After duly examining same and discussing the matter, it was moved by E. W. Leach and seconded by A. M. Walker that said specifications be in all things accepted. The motion carried unanimously and the Mayor declared the specifications as aforesaid duly adopted.

A petition sighed by the volunteer firemen of the City asking the City ommission to re-instate Edgar Jones as Truck driver on the Fire Department, was presented and after duly considering same and discussing the question, it was moved by E. W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Penman that he be re-instated on condition that he conduct himself in a manner in the future that would meet the entire approval of the City

officials of the City. The motion was put by the Mayor and the following vote recorded: Those voting for the motion being, Joe C. Benman, A. M. Walker, W. A. Behannon and E. W. Leach. Those voting against the motion being Dr. J. W. Hawkins, Mayor. The Mayor declared the motion carried by a majority vote of the City Commission and that the said Edgar Jones be re-instated as truck driver on the fire department on the conditions as autlined in the motion.

It appearing to the City Commission and upon recommendation by the City Manager that it would be well to have the stand pipe painted, on motion made by A. M. Walker and seconded by W. A. Behannon, which motion carried unsnimously, the City Manager was instructed to make arrangements at once for having the work done.

Accounts and bills due by the bity to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly audited and allowed by the City Manager. should be paid, by move and second duly made and carried the following accounts were allowed: Lufkin Ice Co. \$6.00; Grow's Filling Station. \$18.62; Leach Grain Co. \$5.00; E.
