The Mayor announced that the purpose of the call meeting was to decide whether or not a home man would be appointed as ty Manager to succeed Mr. Tiner, who has resigned, effective Feby 20th, 1931.

Discussion among the members of the City Commission was had relative to the question, after which it was moved by Commissioner C. A. Burke and seconded by Commissioner W. O. Greene, that the City Commission employ a man to said position who is an experienced Civil Engineer and who is familiar with all duties connected with City Manager's office; one who is qualified to properly supervise new construction work and to properly take care of all city properties as they exist at this time. The following vote is here entered of record as made on said motion: "Ayes"— W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke, and W. A. Abney. "Noes"— Joe C. Denman. The motion carried.

A number of citizens having appeared in behalf of the appointment of a home to such position were given an apportunity to speak. Dr. R. B. Bledsoe, et als did speak, insisting that the City Commission rescind its action and consider the appointment of a home man. The Commission refused to do so.
