when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to de-
clare the result of the General Election held April 5th, 1932 for the
purpose of electing a City Commissioner from Ward No. 2 and City Com-
missioner from Ward No. 4, to work on the new budget and do and per-
form any other work that might properly come before the meeting.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND
DECLARING THE RESULT OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF
LUFKIN ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, A.D. 1932? SAME BEING THE 5th
DAY OF APRIL, 1932, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A COMMISSIONER FROM
WARD NO. 2 AND A COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO. 4" was presented for pas-
sage and approval. Said ordinance having been read to the City Com-
mission, on motion made by W. O. Greene, seconded by M. M. Jones,
said ordinance was passed and approved. (See another page of these

A committee composed of E.L.Kurth, W.C.Binion and H.A.Mass, from
the Community Chest appeared before the City Commission in behalf of
donation by the City to the Community Chest for the purpose of earing
for the unemployed. Their presentation of the matter was listened to
attentively by the City Commission, and said Committee was promised that
when preparing for the budget for the ensuing year that an amount would
be put in the budget under the head of labor to provide employment for
the unemployed at the City Park and for the general clean up campaign
to be hand just before the East Texas Chamber of Commerce Convention
would be held in the City.

It appearing that the City was without a City Engineer, and that
J. O. Booker of Lufkin, was a person qualified for said position and

that frequently the services of a Civil Engineer is needed by the City, it was moved by M. M. Jones and seconded by W. A. Abney that the said J. O. Booker be appointed to said position, his pay to be for work actually performed and to be paid after bill for services are rendered for any work done by him under direction of proper city authority. The Motion carried unanimously, and the said J. O. Booker is hereby appointed City Engineer of the City of Lufkin, Texas, until otherwise provided.



A. Abney and seconded by M. M. Jones, that C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, be appointed Mayor Pro Tem of the City to act as Mayor during the absence of the regularly elected Mayor. The motion carried unanimously, and the said C. A. Burke was so appointed until otherwise provided.
