

Lufkin Texas Oct. 2nd 1917

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met in Regular session on the above date, Oct 2nd 1917 with the following officers present, K. Morgan Mayor presiding, J. A. Beahmon, W. N. Coon, S. W. Hawthorne, W. D. Price and W. D. Newsom aldermen; R. P. Walker Secretary S. H. Townsend City Attorney and A. O. Reed, Deputy City Marshal and pound master when the following orders were made of record;

It is ordered that the mayor and secretary examine the City warrant book as to Mr. D. A. Singleton having been paid for his services as Mayor for the months of Feby. March and April 1917 and if he has not been paid for his services for said months the mayor and secretary are hereby authorized and required to issue to him the said D. A. Singleton a warrant payable out of the general funds of the City for the sum of \$45.99

It is ordered that W. L. Jones water Commissioner place \$ — of the water works fund in the water works Incidental funds

It is ordered that the expense account of W. L. Jones water Commissioner for paying for labor at the water works plant amounting to \$205.00 be paid out of the water works Incidental fund, Newsom Price and Coon voting yes and Hawthorne and Beahmon voting may.

It is ordered that the account of W. L. Jones
as water Commissioner for \$15.00 for six days
salary as water Commissioner in the month of
Nov. 1917 be allowed. —

There being no further business it was moved
and seconded that the Council adjourn and it was so ordered.
