The mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the advisability of calling an election to be held in the City of Lufkin, Texas, to determine whether Section 9, 12 and 13 of the Special Charter of the City of Lufkin, Texas, shall be amended so that same shall provide for the election of a Mayor of said city every two years and two commissioners each year instead of election, four commissioners every two years as same provides now.

After discussing the proposition as above stated by the Mayor, it was moved by Commissioner Woods and Seconded by Commissioner Treadwell, that an election be called for the purpose as above stated. Said motion carried unanamously.
