The city council of the city of Lufkin Texas met in called session on this the 23rd day of May 1917 but there being no business before the council it adjourned to meet again on the 25th day of May 1917 when the council met with the following named officers present K. Morgan, mayor presiding, S. W. Hawthorne J. A. Behannon, W. D. Newsom and G. W. Largent Aldermen, R. P. Walker Secretary and J. W. Dunn City attorney when the following orders were made, to wit:

It is ordered by the Council that \$1681.60 be transferred from the Special Liquidating fund of the City of Lufkin Texas to the Special Water works Improvement fund of said City

It is ordered by the Council that \$53.65 now in Engineering fund # 1, \$9.96 now in Engineering # 2; \$3.80 now in Engineering fund (no number); \$57.28 now in the Special water works fund # 2 and \$126.95 now in the Street and Alley funds of the city of Lufkin Texas be transferred to the following named funds of said City, as follows; \$50.27 to the Dog pound fund \$19.60 to the Special Improvement fund # 4; \$162.50 to Special Improvement fund # 7; \$7.99 to the water works Improvement fund and \$11.28 to the Street & Alley Improvement fund of the city of Lufkin Texas and the City Treasurer of the city of Lufkin Texas is hereby authorized and required

to ballance said fund, namely;
Engineering fund # 1; Engineering fund # 2
Engineering fund (no number) Special
Water works fund # 2. And Street & Alley
fund by making the transfers as hereby
ordered and drop them from the Classified
list of funds of the City of Lufkin Texas.

There being no further business before the
Council it adjourned subject to the call of
mayor.
