The following ordinance was passed:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON BURKE AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH FIRST STREET, SOUTH FIRST STREET WITH ITS INTERSECTION WITH BURKE AVENUE, AND BURKE AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH ANGELINA STREET, IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAME, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

Comissioner Melvin moved that the ordinance be placed on First reading, seconded by Commissioner B. F. Milligan and carried by the following Vote:

CARRIED: Ordinance placed on first reading..

Commissioner Jas. A. Abney moved that the ordinance pass first reading, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Melvin and carried by the following Vote:

The Ordinance is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON BURKE AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH FIRST STREET, SOUTH FIRST STREET WITH ITS INTERSECTION WITH BURKE AVENUE, AND BURKE AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH ANGELINA STREET, IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAME, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, dangerous traffic conditions exist at the intersections of Burke Avenue and South First Street and at the intersections of Burke Avenue and South Angelina Streets in the City of Lufkin, Texas, and there does not exist any ordinance or other regulatory law dealing with traffic at such points, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, deems it advisable to pass such an ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, THAT:

I.

From and after the effective date hereof, it shall be unlawful, and it is hereby declared a misdemeanor for any person to do any act forbidden or fail to perform any act required by this ordinance.

II.

The driver of any vehicle shall not make a "U" turn at the intersection of Burke Avenue and South First Streets in the City of Lufkin, Texas, regardless of the direction in which he is traveling and regardless of which street he is on.

III.

The driver of any vehicle shall, when traveling on Burke Avenue, either in a Westerly or Easterly direction, shall come to a complete Stop before entering the intersection of said Burke Avenue and South First Street

IV.

The driver of any vehicle shall, when traveling one South Angelina Street, either in a Northerly or Southerly direction, come to a complete Stop before entering the intersection of said South Angelina Street and Burke Avenue.

V.

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$200.00.

VI.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication as required and provided in the Charter of the City of Lufkin, Texas.

1. Minutes of meetings held in September were read and approved.
2. Jno. S. Redditt and J. B. Perry appeared before the commission and explained that the old Methodist Church property at North second and Bremond street was sold in January 1941 and was not subject to tax for the year 1941.
3. After discussion of the matter the City tax for 1941 was ordered cancelled upon motion made by Jas. A. Abney, second by R.E. Melvin, all voting yea.
4. The City Tax Roll for 1942 was presented and approved.
5. Mr. Kelley presented Voucher No. 8 by Kock & Fowler in favor of Reynolds & Sutton in the amount of \$1,020.73, estimate for September, and recommended approval for payment.
6. On motion of B.F. Milligan, second by Jas. A. Abney, all voting yea, the voucher was approved for payment.
7. Reynolds & Sutton requested and extension of 180 days time for completing the Street Paving Contract, Unit #2, on account of delays beyond their control.
8. After discussion and extension of Ninety days was granted on resolution offered by R.E. Melvin, second by Jas. A. Abney, all voting yea.
9. Copy of this resolution is attached.
10. Motion was made by B. F. Milligan, second by Jas. A. Abney ratifying a resolution passed in meeting August 6th, accepting certain units of Street Paving as complete, all voted yea.
