An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TAXES TO BE LEVIED?
ASSESSED AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 1938, AND FOR EACH YEAR
THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED AND OR-
DAINED"

was presented for passage and approval on second and final reading. J. B. Per-
ry made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading,
and that it be passed and approved on second and final reading. J. E. Jay
seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the re-
corded vote on the motion.: "AYES" - W.M.Glenn, W.D.Winston, Jr. J.B.Perry
and J.E.Jay. "NOES" - None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried
and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD
OF EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR A.D. 1938"

was presented for passage and approval on first reading. W.D.Winston, Jr. made
a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it be passed
and approved on first reading. J. E. Jay seconded the motion. The Mayor put
the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"-
W.M.Glenn, W.D.Winston, Jr. J.B.Perry and J.E.Jay. "NOES" - None. Whereupon
the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved
on first reading.
