


MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JUNE 3,
1958, at 7:30 P. M.

the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor S. R. Parker, Jr.
2. The minutes of the regular meeting, held May 20, 1958, were read and approved.
3. The City Attorney read the ordinance granting a permit or franchise to Vumore Company of Lufkin, giving permission to use the streets, alleys, and other public places for the operation of a community antenna television distribution service by means of electronic cable system and microwave relay stations in the City of Lufkin. After reading the ordinance, a discussion of same was called for. No one discussed the proposed ordinance. Commissioner W. F. Collins made the motion to pass such ordinance on its first reading, and such motion was seconded by Commissioner H. E. Rowin. The Mayor called for a vote, and Commissioners Collins, Rowin, and Metteauer and Mayor Parker voted in favor of passing such ordinance on its first reading. Commissioner Royle abstained from voting, and under the City Charter his vote was recorded "yea."
4. The subdivision ordinance was passed for further study, and for discussion at a later date. The motion was made and seconded that D. & H. Construction Company be paid the balance of 10% due it, which had been withheld at a previous meeting.
5. The City Manager gave an open item report. Several matters were discussed, but no official action was taken.
6. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
