

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD on
SEPTEMBER 23rd, A. D. 1937.

Be it remembered that on this the 23rd day of September A.D. 1937,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the fol-
lowing officers present and presiding, to-wit:

W. D. Winston, Jr. Commissioner of Ward No. 1 was absent.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The purpose of the meeting, it being a joint meeting with the Com-
missioners' Court of Angelina County, Texas, was to discuss the question
of providing quarters for the WPA Sewing Room Projects in this County,
and to decide on a location of such quarters/

The matter having been considered from various points and after hav-
ing given the same due consideration, it was moved by J. B. Perry and sec-
onded by J. E. Jay that quarters over the First State Bank and Trust Co-
mpany be taken at a price of \$75.00 per month, the City to pay one half
of such amount and the County of Angelina to pay the other one-half. The
Motion was put by the Mayor and it carried unanimously.

There came up for consideration a matter in which W.C.Turner, police-
man, had had some trouble with a man passing through the City and had
slapped the said man. The matter having been considered carefully, it
was moved by J.B.Perry and Seconded J. E. Jay that the said W.C.Turner
be suspended from the service for a period of sixty days without pay, ef-
fective at once. The motion carried unanimously. (Later- At another meeti
ing of the City Commission the next day, it was moved by J.B.Perry and sec-
onded by J.E.Jay that the action of the City Commission suspending the said
W. C. Turner be repealed and revoked, which said motion carried unanimous-
ly - the same members of the City Commission being present/

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion
duly made and carried, it adjourned.
