constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Minutes of meetings held during September was read and approved.
2. The matter of Lease on Jones Lake Property to Mr. J. D. Martin which expires November 1, was presented and on motion by B. F. Milligan and second by J.A. Abney, the request by J.D. Martin for renewal was approved.
3. A written request signed by the business representatives in the 200 (two-hundred) block of East Lufkin Avenue, requesting that the South side of the block be included in the 2(two) hour parking zone was read. *Arch*
4. On motion and second, duly carried, the Ordinance including the South side of the 200(two-hundred) block on East Lufkin Avenue in the 2 (two) hour parking zone was passed on the first and second reading.
5. Request was made of the City Commission that the \$25.00 License Fee collected from a carnival sponsored by the V.F.W., be contributed to the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and on motion by Arthur Temple, Jr, second by J.A. Abney, and carried by unanimous vote, the contribution was authorized.
6. The 1944 City Tax Roll was presented and by motion by B. F. Milligan, second by M. D. Thrash, duly carried, was approved.

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There were no further business presented and the meeting adjourned.
