Jupkin Texas Nov. 6th 1917

The City Council of the City of Jupkin Texas met on this the 6th day of Nov. 1917 in regular session with the following named officers present K. Morgan mayor presiding, S. W. Hawthorne W. D. Price W. D. Newsom and J. A. Behannon aldermen R. P. Walker secretary and S. H. Townsend City Attorney when the following orders were made;

It is ordered that the City Tax collector of the City of Jupkin Texas place all tax money that he may collect by the Tax Rolls of 1917 as general fund taxes in the Treasury of the city in the funds of said City known as Special Treasury Time warrant number one and number two.

All claims against the city were allowed and ordered paid as will appear from number 2100 to 2163 in Warrant Book No. 2

There being no further business before the Council it was moved and seconded that the Council adjourn subject to the call of the mayor and it was so ordered
